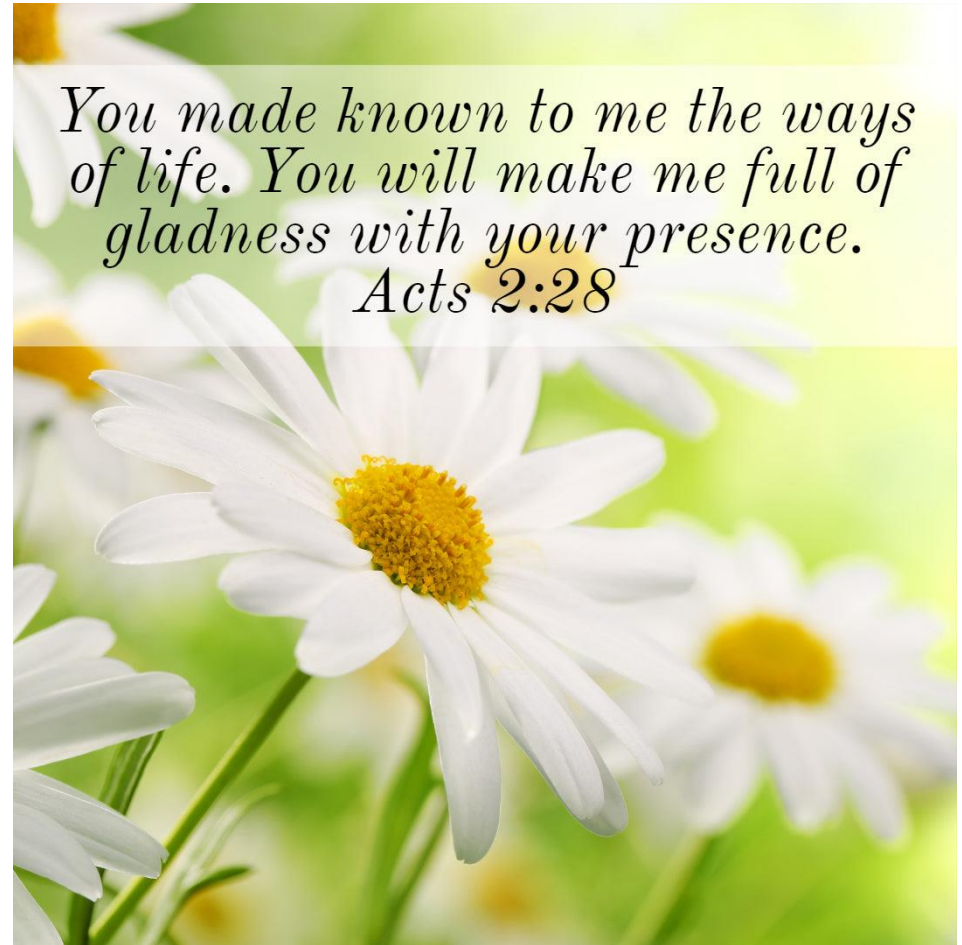
Hillcrest Academy:
